Adult and Dislocated Worker Services are funded through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act, and provide job search assistance and retraining to individuals who are considered low income or who are receiving or eligible to receive unemployment compensation or food assistance. The purpose of the services is to help job seekers access employment, education, training, and support services to succeed in the labor market and to match employers with the skilled workers they need to compete.
