

What is Registered Apprenticeship

Apprenticeship is an industry-driven, high-quality career pathway where employers can develop and prepare their future workforce, and individuals can obtain paid work experience, classroom instruction, and a paid work experience, classroom instruction, and a portable, nationally recognized credential.






SYSTEM WITH NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED CREDENTIALS

WHAT IS A PRE-APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM?

Program or set of strategies that is designed to prepare individuals to enter and succeed in a Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP).

*Can occur during high school or post graduation

- Introduction to various apprenticeship programs
- Industry tours to employer partners with apprenticeship opportunities
- Guest Speakers JATC/Training Providers and Employers
- Short-term credential training programs as pathway to apprenticeship programs
- Dual enrollment in Youth Services and Career Connect Support programs
- Direct connection to and application support for Registered Apprenticeship Programs







YOUTH APPRENTICESHIPS

Youth Benefits

- Expanded Post Secondary Options
- Work-Based/Experiential Learning Earn as you learn
- Start in High School
 - Career and Technical Education (CTE) Free short-term training
 - CTE courses directly related to the apprenticeship field in addition to required high school coursework - counts toward high school graduation
 - Dual enrollment/Early Middle College Free college tuition and college credit
 - Portable, stackable, nationally recognized credentials and certifications
 - On-the-job learning activities (beginning at age 16) counts toward Registered Apprenticeship
 - Students can apply to a Registered Apprenticeship program leading up to or upon high school graduation

Apprenticeship

- During his 13th year of school in the EMC program, Kyle participated in an apprenticeship program and attended classes at KVCC where he pursued his Associates of Applied Science, IT Support Technician
- Kyle also earned these additional certificates through the apprenticeship program: PC Support Technician, Network Manager, and Desk Side Support
- At the completion of Kyle's apprenticeship, he was offered and accepted a permanent position as a Help Desk Technician at KRESA
- Competency-Based Apprenticeship completed June 2023
