





McGee has been working around 14 hours a week at American Axle since January 2023, a week at American Ade since January 2023, when he found out about the position. "When our county CTE program went to American Aute during Manufacturing Week, they tool us they would be accepting applications for high school co-ops, and I applied," he says. 
